

What is a B.O.B. Binder?

- A BOB binder is a special notebook that your student will carry to and from school every day.
- BOB is an acronym for **Brilliantly Organized Bobcats**
- The BOB binder will help your student stay organized and keep you in touch with our classroom

B.O.B. Binder Sections

- Inside pocket: Holds important information and papers that require parent attention and may need to be returned to school, completed work can also be found here
- Clear sleeves: Dojo point tracker, daily schedule, grading requirements
- Reading tab: Contains guidelines for nightly reading and reading club checklist along with progress tracking
- Math: Contains math homework helpers along with progress tracking
- Portfolio: Contains work your student is particularly proud of
- Back pocket: Holds homework and unfinished classwork that needs to be completed. Please help your child remember to put the assignments back in the pocket when finished.
